Site 04 – Peka Peka Road (50 km/h extension)	Length of Road: 130 m
AADT: 1,002 vehicles per day	Existing Speed Limit: 60 km/h
Class of Road: Peri Urban	Proposed Speed Limit: 50 km/h

Safety:

There have been zero injury crashes at this site over the last 5 years. The mean operating speed is expected to decrease by 3.7 km/h, the number of expected injury crashes per year is anticipated to remain unchanged.

Travel Time:

It is expected that the mean operating speed will reduce by 3.7 km/h, and there will be an increase in travel time of 0.4 seconds for each vehicle and an estimated increase of 40 hours for all traffic over a year.

Implementation Cost

The implementation cost of this speed limit change is estimated to be \$18,590.

Summary

WSP prepared this statement based on Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2024, as of 15 January 2025, as per clause 3.3, which considers crash impacts, travel time impacts, and implementation costs (as shown in Table 1 below), for a proposed posted speed limit on this section of Peka Peka Road of 50 km/h.
