

Cost Benefit Disclosure Statement

Site 01A – Marine Parade (Howell to Kāpiti Road)	Length of Road: 175 m
AADT: 4,245 vehicles per day	Existing Speed Limit: 50 km/h
Class of Road: Urban Streets with significant levels of pedestrian and/or cycling activity	Proposed Speed Limit: 30 km/h

Safety:

There have been zero injury crashes at this site over the last 5 years. The mean operating speed is expected to decrease by 6.3 km/h, resulting in a potential decrease of 0.01 expected injury crashes per year.

Travel Time:

It is expected that the mean operating speed will reduce by 6.3 km/h, and there will be an increase in travel time of 2.9 seconds for each vehicle and an estimated increase of 1,260 hours for all traffic over a year.

Implementation Cost

The implementation cost of this speed limit change is estimated to be \$1,859.

Summary

WSP prepared this statement based on Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2024, as of 15 January 2025, as per clause 3.3, which considers crash impacts, travel time impacts, and implementation costs (as shown in Table 1 below), for a proposed posted speed limit on this section of Marine Parade of 30 km/h.
